

HB 1331 -- HEALTH INSURANCE FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS

SPONSOR: Parkinson

This bill prohibits a public university, as a condition of enrollment, from binding any student to a third-party contract for the provision of health insurance without the written approval of the student or the guardian of the student. Any student who shows proof of existing health insurance coverage to the public university, at any time during the student's enrollment at the public university, must be excused from the payment of any fees, costs, or related expenses for the provision of health insurance as required by the public university.
