

HB 1353 -- LAW ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

SPONSOR: Mitten

This bill requires each peace officer to provide an oral advisement and obtain verbal or written consent for a voluntary search of an individual not under arrest, a person's effect, or a vehicle. These provisions do not apply to a search conducted by a peace officer who has probable cause, a valid search incident to or subsequent to a lawful arrest or a search for which there is a legal basis other than voluntary consent.
