

HRB 666 -- OBSOLETE STATUTORY PROVISIONS

SPONSOR: Flanigan

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Government Efficiency by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass with a HCS" by the Select Committee on General Laws by a vote of 8 to 0.

This bill repeals specified obsolete, overruled, and expired statutory provisions regarding:

- (1) The expired audit requirement in the Veterans Commission Capital Improvement Trust Fund (Section 42.300, RSMo);
- (2) The expired audit requirement in the Early Childhood Development, Education and Care Fund (Section 161.215);
- (3) An outdated statutory reference in the Early Childhood Development, Education and Care Fund (Section 161.215);
- (4) The expired mandatory monthly payments to the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education to sheltered workshops (Section 178.930);
- (5) An expired mandate establishing the Joint Committee on Missouri's Energy Future (Section 21.830);
- (6) An expired mandate establishing the Joint Committee on Recovery, Accountability, and Transparency (Section 33.850);
- (7) An obsolete requirement that candidates for municipal office be current on municipal taxes that have been assessed against them (Section 71.005);
- (8) The expired Missouri Health Care Access Fund (Section 135.575);
- (9) The expired Qualified Equity Investment Tax Credit (Sections 135.575);
- (10) The expired tax credit for film production companies (Section 135.750);
- (11) The obsolete contingent corporate income tax and restriction upon deductions (Sections 143.105 - 143.107);
- (12) The expired After-school Retreat Reading and Assessment Grant Program Fund (Section 143.1008);

- (13) The expired required vision examination for specified elementary students (Section 167.194);
- (14) The expired Missouri Teaching Fellows Program (Section 168.700);
- (15) The obsolete Higher Education Scholarship Program (Section 208.178);
- (16) The expired eligibility for health insurance coverage through Medicaid (Section 208.178);
- (17) The obsolete Coordinating Council on Special Transportation (Section 208.630);
- (18) The expired Joint Committee on Medicaid Transformation (Section 208.993);
- (19) The expired unemployment automation surcharge (Section 288.131);
- (20) The obsolete program to collect contributions to the World War II Memorial Trust Fund (Section 301.3031);
- (21) The expired Missouri Oral Chemotherapy Parity Interim Committee (Section 338.321); and
- (22) The expired long-term Care Health Insurance Pool (Sections 376.960 - 376.989).

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that this bill will help repeal statutes which are no longer operative and thus are superfluous.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Flanigan.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
