7 purchasing rules. The provider must have experience serving this population in a correctional setting  
8 as well as in the community. The provider shall design and implement an evidence-based program  
9 that includes a continuum of services from prison to community, including medication assisted  
10 treatment that is initiated prior to release, when appropriate. The program must include an  
11 evaluation component to determine its effectiveness relative to other options
