1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill
2 No. 663, Page39 , Section 304.351, Line 77, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "304.826. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the court of jurisdiction shall sentence a
5 defendant who is eighteen years of age or younger to perform community service under the community
6 service program established in subsection 2 of this section and such conditions as may be established by the
7 court, in lieu of paying restitution, court costs, fees, expenses, or fines, for all traffic offenses deemed
8 infractions or class C misdemeanors under this chapter or violations of any ordinance or political subdivision
9 of this state.

10 2. There is hereby established the "Community Service Program", which shall include the
11 performance of services at a local, regional, or state level, as determined by the court of jurisdiction. Such
12 services shall be directed toward residents, businesses, schools, and churches. Such program shall also
13 provide defendants under subsection 1 of this section with the following:

14 (1) Job skill training;

15 (2) Psychological, drug-related, social, or family counseling, as deemed appropriate; and

16 (3) Guided inclusion in positive youth-directed activities and peer counseling.

17 3. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Community Service Program Fund", which shall
18 consist of moneys from any gifts, contributions, grants, bequests, or other aid received from federal, private,
19 or other sources. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and
20 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon
21 appropriation, moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the administration of this section.

22 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the
23 end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest
24 moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such
25 investments shall be credited to the fund.

26 4. Under section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:

27 (1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall automatically sunset six
28 years after the effective date of this section unless reauthorized by an act of the general assembly; and

29 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section shall automatically
30 sunset twelve years after the effective date of the reauthorization of this section; and

31 (3) This section shall terminate on September first of the calendar year immediately following the
32 calendar year in which the program authorized under this section is sunset."; and
