1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 861,
2 Page 1, In the Title, Line 3, by deleting the word "facilities"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 10, Section 143.2115, Line 136, by inserting after all of said section
5 and line the following:

7 "227.432. The portion of Interstate 470 at the interchange with Woods Chapel Road
8 continuing to Lakewood Boulevard in Jackson County shall be designated as the "Judge Vincent E.
9 Baker Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate
10 signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid for by private donations.

11 227.446. The portion of U.S. Highway 50 from County Line Road continuing west to
12 Mockingbird Road in Moniteau County shall be designated as the "Phyllis D. Shelley Memorial
13 Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating
14 such highway, with costs to be paid for by private donation."; and

16 Further amend said bill, Page 11, Section 227.600, Line 57, by inserting after all of said section and
17 line the following:

19 "311.328. 1. A valid and unexpired operator's or chauffeur's license issued under the
20 provisions of section 302.177, or a valid and unexpired operator's or chauffeur's license issued under
21 the laws of any state or territory of the United States to residents of those states or territories, or a
22 valid and unexpired identification card or nondriver's license as provided for under section 302.181,
23 or a valid and unexpired nondriver's license issued under the laws of any state or territory of the
24 United States to residents of those states or territories, or a valid and unexpired identification card
25 issued by any uniformed service of the United States, or a valid and unexpired passport shall be
26 presented by the holder thereof upon request of any agent of the division of alcohol and tobacco
27 control or any licensee or the servant, agent or employee thereof for the purpose of aiding the
28 licensee or the servant, agent or employee to determine whether or not the person is at least twenty-
29 one years of age when such person desires to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages procured
30 from a licensee. Upon such presentation the licensee or the servant, agent or employee thereof shall
31 compare the photograph and physical characteristics noted on the license, identification card or
32 passport with the physical characteristics of the person presenting the license, identification card or
33 passport.

34 2. Upon proof by the licensee of full compliance with the provisions of this section, no
35 penalty shall be imposed if the supervisor of the division of alcohol and tobacco control or the
36 courts are satisfied that the licensee acted in good faith.

1 3. Any person who shall, without authorization from the department of revenue, reproduce,
2 alter, modify, or misrepresent any chauffeur's license, motor vehicle operator's license or
3 identification card shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to
4 a fine of not more than one thousand dollars, and confinement for not more than one year, or by
5 both such fine and imprisonment."; and

7 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
8 accordingly.
