1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1601, Page 1, In the Title, Line 3, by  
2 deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the words "elementary and secondary  
3 education."; and

4  
5 Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 161.072, Line 16, by inserting after all of said section and  
6 line the following:

8 "161.960. 1. There is hereby established in the department of elementary and secondary  
9 education a "Council for Community Education".

10 2. The council shall have a membership of eleven persons, who shall be appointed by the  
11 governor. Membership may include, but not be limited to, representatives of the following groups:

- 12 (1) Civic organizations;
- 13 (2) Community-based organizations;
- 14 (3) Community education organizations;
- 15 (4) Local government;
- 16 (5) Local school district administrators;
- 17 (6) Parent organizations;
- 18 (7) Postsecondary education;
- 19 (8) School boards; and
- 20 (9) Teachers.

21 3. The commissioner of education or the commissioner's designee shall convene the first  
22 meeting of the council for the purpose of establishing the bylaws of the council and electing officers  
23 to include a chairperson, vice chairperson, and secretary. The council shall not meet more than four  
24 times annually. Members may be reimbursed for expenses but shall not receive a per diem  
25 allowance.

26 4. The council shall:

- 27 (1) Conduct feasibility studies on the establishment of community education programs  
28 within the state;
- 29 (2) Advise the commissioner of education and the department of elementary and secondary  
30 education on issues relating to the establishment of community education programs;
- 31 (3) Make recommendations for a state plan for community education that sets forth the  
32 goals and objectives of a community schools program and establishes a system of priorities for  
33 targeting available resources on the areas with the greatest need within a school district; and
- 34 (4) Make recommendations for the funding of local community education programs.

35 5. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

- 36 (1) "Community education program", a program in which a public building, including a

1 public elementary or secondary school, is used as a community center operated by a school board in  
2 cooperation with other groups in the community, community organizations, and local governmental  
3 agencies to provide educational, recreational, cultural, health care, and other related community  
4 services in accordance with the needs, interests, and concerns of the community;

5 (2) "Community school", a school that makes its facilities available for citizen use,  
6 coordinates activities of local citizens in identifying program needs and establishing priorities,  
7 identifies and utilizes available program resources, and assists in the initiation of programs to  
8 improve the cultural, social, recreational, and educational opportunities available in a community.";

11 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
12 accordingly.  
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
