1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1658, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2-3, by
2 deleting the words "the show-me compassionate medical education act" and inserting in lieu thereof
3 the words "health care"; and

5 Further amend said bill and page, Section 9.154, Line 11, by inserting after all of said line the
6 following:

8 "191.117. 1. There is hereby established in the department of health and senior services a "Sickle
9 Cell Standing Committee" as a subcommittee of the Missouri genetic advisory committee. The
10 committee shall consist of the following members:

11 (1) One member who is a licensed physician with experience in the diagnosis and treatment
12 of sickle cell disease and who shall serve as chair of the committee;

13 (2) One member who has sickle cell disease or is a family member of a person with sickle
14 cell disease;

15 (3) One member with expertise in sickle cell disease research;

16 (4) One member from a leading sickle cell disease organization;

17 (5) One member with expertise in minority health; and

18 (6) One member from each of the hemoglobinopathy centers which contracts with the
19 department.

20 2. The members of the committee shall be appointed by the director of the department of
21 health and senior services. Members shall serve on the committee without compensation or
22 reimbursement for expenses incurred.

23 3. The committee shall:

24 (1) Assess the impact of sickle cell disease on urban communities in the state of Missouri;

25 (2) Examine the existing services and resources addressing the needs of persons with sickle
26 cell disease; and

27 (3) Develop recommendations to provide educational services to schools on the traits of
28 sickle cell disease and its effects.

29 4. The committee shall include an examination of the following in its assessment and
30 recommendations required under subsection 3 of this section:

31 (1) Trends in state sickle cell disease populations and their needs including, but not limited
32 to, the state's role in providing assistance;

33 (2) Existing services and resources;

34 (3) Needed state policies or responses including, but not limited to, directions for the
35 provision of clear and coordinated services and supports to persons living with sickle cell disease
36 and strategies to address any identified gaps in services; and

1 (4) Replacing the hour-long genetic testing and counseling program workshop provided to
2 schools on the traits of sickle cell disease and the effects of such traits, which was eliminated due to
3 lack of funding.

4 5. The committee shall hold a minimum of one meeting at three urban regions in the state of
5 Missouri to seek public input.

6 6. The committee shall submit a report of its findings and any recommendations to the
7 general assembly and the governor no later than December 31, 2017.

8 7. After December 31, 2017, the committee shall continue to meet at the request of the chair
9 and at a minimum of one time annually for the purpose of continuing the study of sickle cell disease
10 in this state, the impact of the committee recommendations, and to provide an annual supplemental
11 report on the findings to the governor and the general assembly. "; and

13 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section B, Line 2, by deleting the words "this act is" and insert in
14 lieu thereof the following:

16 "sections 9.154, 191.594, and 191.596 of Section A of this act are"; and

18 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Line 3, by deleting the word "is" and inserting in lieu
19 thereof the word "are"; and

21 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Line 4, by inserting after the word "and" the following:

23 "sections 9.154, 191.594, and 191.596 of Section A of"; and

25 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
