1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 608, Page 4,
2 Section 208.800, Line 3, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "338.202. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, unless the prescriber has specified
5 on the prescription that dispensing a prescription for a maintenance medication in an initial amount
6 followed by periodic refills is medically necessary, a pharmacist may exercise his or her
7 professional judgment to dispense varying quantities of maintenance medication per fill up to the
8 total number of dosage units as authorized by the prescriber on the original prescription, including
9 any refills. Dispensing of the maintenance medication based on refills authorized by the physician
10 on the prescription shall be limited to no more than a ninety-day supply of the medication, and the
11 maintenance medication shall have been previously prescribed to the patient for at least a three-
12 month period.

13 2. For the purposes of this section "maintenance medication" is a medication prescribed for
14 chronic, long-term conditions and is taken on a regular, recurring basis, except that it shall not
15 include controlled substances as defined in section 195.010."; and
