1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 665, Page 14, Section 414.082, Line 27,
2 by inserting immediately after said line the following:

3 "442.571. 1. Except as provided in sections 442.586 and 442.591, no alien or foreign
4 business shall acquire by grant, purchase, devise, descent or otherwise agricultural land in this state
5 if the total aggregate alien and foreign ownership of agricultural acreage in this state exceeds three-
6 tenths of one percent of the total aggregate agricultural acreage in this state. A sale or transfer of
7 any agricultural land in this state shall be submitted to the director of the department of agriculture
8 for review in accordance with subsection 3 of this section only if there is no completed Internal
9 Revenue Service Form W-9 signed by the purchaser. No person may hold agricultural land as an
10 agent, trustee, or other fiduciary for an alien or foreign business in violation of sections 442.560 to
11 442.592, provided, however, that no security interest in such agricultural land shall be divested or
12 invalidated by such violation.

13 2. Any alien or foreign business who acquires agricultural land in violation of sections
14 442.560 to 442.592 remains in violation of sections 442.560 to 442.592 for as long as he or she
15 holds an interest in the land, provided, however, that no security interest in such agricultural land
16 shall be divested or invalidated by such violation.

17 3. Subject to the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, such proposed acquisitions by
18 grant, purchase, devise, descent, or otherwise of agricultural land in this state shall be submitted to
19 the department of agriculture to determine whether such acquisition of agricultural land is conveyed
20 in accordance with the three-tenths of one percent restriction on the total aggregate alien and foreign
21 ownership of agricultural land in this state. The department shall establish by rule the requirements
22 for submission and approval of requests under this subsection.

23 4. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created
24 under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is
25 subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and
26 chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to
27 chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently
28 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
29 August 28, 2014, shall be invalid and void."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
