1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1732, Page 1, in the Title, Line 3, by  
2 deleting the word "vehicles" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "traffic"; and

3  
4 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 304.170, Line 111, by inserting immediately after all of  
5 said line the following:

7 "304.826. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the court of jurisdiction shall  
8 sentence a defendant who is eighteen years of age or younger to perform community service under  
9 the community service program established in subsection 2 of this section and such conditions as  
10 may be established by the court, in lieu of paying restitution, court costs, fees, expenses, or fines,  
11 for all traffic offenses deemed infractions or class C misdemeanors under this chapter or violations  
12 of any ordinance or political subdivision of this state.

13 2. There is hereby established the "Community Service Program", which shall include the  
14 performance of services at a local, regional, or state level, as determined by the court of jurisdiction.  
15 Such services shall be directed toward residents, businesses, schools, and churches. Such program  
16 shall also provide defendants under subsection 1 of this section with the following:

17 (1) Job skill training;

18 (2) Psychological, drug-related, social, or family counseling, as deemed appropriate; and

19 (3) Guided inclusion in positive youth-directed activities and peer counseling.

20 3. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Community Service Program Fund",  
21 which shall consist of moneys from any gifts, contributions, grants, bequests, or other aid received  
22 from federal, private, or other sources. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In  
23 accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The  
24 fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, moneys in the fund shall be used solely for  
25 the administration of this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary,  
26 any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the  
27 general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as  
28 other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to  
29 the fund.

30 4. Under section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:

31 (1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall automatically  
32 sunset six years after the effective date of this section unless reauthorized by an act of the general  
33 assembly; and

34 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section shall  
35 automatically sunset twelve years after the effective date of the reauthorization of this section; and

36 (3) This section shall terminate on September first of the calendar year immediately
