1 AMEND Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 919, Page 4,
2 Section 311.198, Line 20, by inserting after the phrase, "retail location." the following:

4 "For the purposes of this section, a brewer shall include any business whose primary activity is the
5 brewing, manufacturing, and selling of intoxicating liquor along with such business' wholly and
6 partially owned subsidiaries, parent or holding companies, interest holders, or affiliates thereof.";

9 Further amend said bill, Page 9, Section 311.220, Lines 23-31, by deleting all of said lines; and

11 Further amend said bill, Page 10, Section 311.665, Line 1-8, by deleting all of said section and lines
12 from the bill; and

13
14 Further amend said bill and page, Section 311.915, Lines 1-9, by deleting all of said lines and
15 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

17 "311.915. A special permit may be issued to an out of state manufacturer of beer or malt
18 liquor who is licensed in another state but is not licensed in the state of Missouri for participation in
19 festivals, bazaars, or similar events. Permit holders under this section may provide beer or malt
20 liquor for sampling purposes in organized events, exhibitions, or competitions. Samples of beer or
21 malt liquor used at an organized event where an admission fee is paid for entry, and where the beer
22 or malt liquor is available without a separate charge, shall not be deemed a sale of beer or malt
23 liquor pursuant to a temporary retail license issued under sections 311.218, 311.482, 311.485,
24 311.486, or 311.487, or any tax exempt organization's licensed premises as described in section
25 311.090, provided that the permit holder licensed under this section receives no proceeds from the
26 admission fee, and all consumption is conducted off licensed retail premises. Before a permit is
27 issued under this section, the applicant's product shall be approved by the federal Alcohol and
28 Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau. The amount of beer or malt liquor shipped into the state under this
29 permit shall not exceed two hundred gallons. Excise taxes shall be paid by the holder of the special
30 permit issued under this section. A permit issued"; and
