1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1928, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by  
2 inserting immediately after said line the following:

3  
4 "161.960. 1. There is hereby established in the department of elementary and secondary  
5 education a "Council for Community Education".

6 2. The council shall have a membership of eleven persons, who shall be appointed by the  
7 governor. Membership may include, but not be limited to, representatives of the following groups:

8 (1) Civic organizations;

9 (2) Community-based organizations;

10 (3) Community education organizations;

11 (4) Local government;

12 (5) Local school district administrators;

13 (6) Parent organizations;

14 (7) Postsecondary education;

15 (8) School boards; and

16 (9) Teachers.

17 3. The commissioner of education or the commissioner's designee shall convene the first  
18 meeting of the council for the purpose of establishing the bylaws of the council and electing officers  
19 to include a chairperson, vice chairperson, and secretary. The council shall not meet more than four  
20 times annually. Members may be reimbursed for expenses but shall not receive a per diem  
21 allowance.

22 4. The council shall:

23 (1) Conduct feasibility studies on the establishment of community education programs  
24 within the state;

25 (2) Advise the commissioner of education and the department of elementary and secondary  
26 education on issues relating to the establishment of community education programs;

27 (3) Make recommendations for a state plan for community education that sets forth the  
28 goals and objectives of a community schools program and establishes a system of priorities for  
29 targeting available resources on the areas with the greatest need within a school district; and

30 (4) Make recommendations for the funding of local community education programs.

31 5. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

32 (1) "Community education program", a program in which a public building, including a  
33 public elementary or secondary school, is used as a community center operated by a school board in  
34 cooperation with other groups in the community, community organizations, and local governmental  
35 agencies to provide educational, recreational, cultural, health care, and other related community  
36 services in accordance with the needs, interests, and concerns of the community;

2 coordinates activities of local citizens in identifying program needs and establishing priorities,
