1 AMEND House Amendment No. ____ to House Bill No. 2069, Page 2, Line 2, by inserting after
2 all of said line the following:

4 "2. The tissue report shall include:

5 (1) The pathologist's estimation, to a reasonable degree of scientific certainty, of the
6 gestational age of the fetal remains;

7 (2) Whether all tissue and remains of a human fetus were received that would be common
8 for a specimen of such estimated gestational age;

9 (3) If the pathologist finds that all tissue and remains of a human fetus were not received,
10 what portion of the tissue and remains of a human fetus were not received;

11 (4) A gross diagnosis and detailed gross findings of what was received including the percent
12 blood clot and the percent tissue

13 (5) The date the tissue and remains of a human fetus were remitted to be disposed and the
14 location of such disposal;

15 (6) A certification that all submitted tissue and remains of a human fetus have been disposed
16 in accordance with state laws and regulations; and

17 (7) The name of the entity and physical address of the entity conducting the examination of
18 the specimen containing the remains of a human fetus."; and

20 Further amend said amendment and page, Lines 3 through 33, by renumber subsequent subsections
21 accordingly;

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23 Further amend said amendment and page, Line 33, by inserting after all of said line the following:

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25 "188.052. 1. An individual abortion report for each abortion performed or induced upon a
26 woman shall be completed by her attending physician. The report shall include:

27 (1) The attending physician's estimation, to a reasonable degree of scientific certainty, of
28 the gestational age of the fetal remains;

29 (2) Whether all tissue and remains of a human fetus, as defined in section 194.375, were
30 removed that would be common for a specimen of such estimated gestational age; and

31 (3) If the attending physician finds that all tissue and remains of a human fetus were not
32 removed, what portion of the tissue and remains of a human fetus were not removed.

33 2. An individual complication report for any post-abortion care performed upon a woman

1 shall be completed by the physician providing such post-abortion care. This report shall include:

2 (1) The date of the abortion;

3 (2) The name and address of the abortion facility or hospital where the abortion was
4 performed;

5 (3) The nature of the abortion complication diagnosed or treated.

6 3. All abortion reports shall be signed by the attending physician, and submitted to the state
7 department of health and senior services within forty-five days from the date of the abortion. All
8 complication reports shall be signed by the physician providing the post-abortion care and submitted
9 to the department of health and senior services within forty-five days from the date of the post-
10 abortion care.

11 4. A copy of the abortion report shall be made a part of the medical record of the patient of
12 the facility or hospital in which the abortion was performed.

13 5. The state department of health and senior services shall be responsible for collecting all
14 abortion reports and complication reports and collating and evaluating all data gathered therefrom
15 and shall annually publish a statistical report based on such data from abortions performed in the
16 previous calendar year."; and

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18 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
19 accordingly.
