1 AMEND House Bill No. 1979, Page 1, in the title, lines 2 and 3, by deleting the phrase "solely to
2 registered lobbyists" and inserting in lieu thereof the phrase "to ethics"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and line the
5 following:

7 "105.453. 1. No member of the general assembly shall act or serve as a lobbyist, register as
8 a lobbyist, or solicit clients to represent as a lobbyist until three years after the expiration of any
9 term of office for which such member is elected. Paid full-time employees of such members shall
10 also be barred from acting or serving as a lobbyist, registering as a lobbyist, or soliciting clients to
11 represent as a lobbyist until one year after termination of such employees' employment.

12 2. No member of the general assembly shall be compensated for acting or serving as an
13 elected local government official lobbyist, or shall solicit clients to represent as such a lobbyist
14 while serving a term as a member of the general assembly.

15 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 2 of this section to the contrary, a member
16 of the general assembly may, without compensation, act or serve as a lobbyist for and solicit clients
17 to represent as a lobbyist for religious and charitable associations organized under chapter 352
18 immediately upon vacating such member's office as a member of the general assembly.

19 4. For the purposes of this section, the terms "lobbyist" and "elected local government
20 official lobbyist" shall have the same meaning as in section 105.470."; and

22 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
23 accordingly.
