1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 921, Page 1, In the Title, Line 3, by deleting the
2 words "domestic violence" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "criminal proceedings"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 455.545, Line 4, by inserting after all of said section and line the
5 following:

7 "476.083. 1. In addition to any appointments made pursuant to section 485.010, the presiding judge
8 of each circuit containing one or more facilities operated by the department of corrections with an average
9 total inmate population in all such facilities in the circuit over the previous two years of more than two
10 thousand five hundred inmates or containing, as of January 1, 2016, a diagnostic and reception center
11 operated by the department of corrections and a mental health facility operated by the department of mental
12 health which houses persons found not guilty of a crime by reason of mental disease or defect under chapter
13 552 and provides sex offender rehabilitation and treatment services (SORTS) may appoint a circuit court
14 marshal to aid the presiding judge in the administration of the judicial business of the circuit by overseeing
15 the physical security of the courthouse, serving court-generated papers and orders, and assisting the judges of
16 the circuit as the presiding judge determines appropriate. Such circuit court marshal appointed pursuant to
17 the provisions of this section shall serve at the pleasure of the presiding judge. The circuit court marshal
18 authorized by this section is in addition to staff support from the circuit clerks, deputy circuit clerks, division
19 clerks, municipal clerks, and any other staff personnel which may otherwise be provided by law.

20 2. The salary of a circuit court marshal shall be established by the presiding judge of the circuit
21 within funds made available for that purpose, but such salary shall not exceed ninety percent of the salary of
22 the highest paid sheriff serving a county wholly or partially within that circuit. Personnel authorized by this
23 section shall be paid from state funds or federal grant moneys which are available for that purpose and not
24 from county funds.

25 3. Any person appointed as a circuit court marshal pursuant to this section shall have at least five
26 years' prior experience as a law enforcement officer. In addition, any such person shall within one year after
27 appointment, or as soon as practicable, attend a court security school or training program operated by the
28 United States Marshal Service. In addition to all other powers and duties prescribed in this section, a circuit
29 court marshal may:

- 30 (1) Serve process;
- 31 (2) Wear a concealable firearm; and
- 32 (3) Make an arrest based upon local court rules and state law, and as directed by the presiding judge
33 of the circuit."; and

35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
