1 AMEND House Bill No. 2724, Page 2, Section 486.245, Line 7, by inserting immediately after all
2 of said section and line the following:

4 "486.275. 1. At the time of notarization a notary public shall sign his official signature on
5 each notary certificate.

6 2. If a signature or record is required to be notarized, acknowledged, verified, or made
7 under oath, the requirement is satisfied if the electronic signature of the person authorized to
8 perform such acts, together with all other information required to be included, is attached to or
9 logically associated with the signature or record.

10 3. The secretary of state shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
11 Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the
12 authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to
13 all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter
14 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter
15 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
16 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
17 August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void."; and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
20 accordingly.
