1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2327, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by
2 inserting immediately after said line the following:

3 "174.125. 1. All teacher-training institutions, receiving state aid, shall provide courses in
4 physical education, first aid, and cardiopulmonary resuscitation for the proper preparation of
5 teachers to carry out the rules and regulations of the state board of education as provided in section
6 161.102. Each of the five state colleges shall provide extension service of properly trained and
7 qualified field advisers for the teachers and others engaged in carrying out the provisions of sections
8 161.102 and 168.171 within their several territorial jurisdictions, such jurisdiction to be established
9 and coordinated by the state commissioner of education.

10 2. Such teacher-training institutions as provided in subsection 1 of this section shall provide
11 a course for teachers for annual recertification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

12 3. In addition to the requirements of subsection 1 of this section, all teacher-training
13 institutions receiving state aid shall require students to demonstrate proficiency on the concepts of
14 trauma-informed approach and trauma-specific interventions as defined by the Substance Abuse and
15 Mental Health Services Division within the United States Department of Health and Senior
16 Services."; and

18 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
19 accordingly.
