1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2399, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2 and 3,
2 by deleting the words "the establishment of special license plates for Missouri Boys State and
3 Missouri Girls State" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "transportation"; and

5 Further amend said bill and page, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and line
6 the following:

8 "227.218. 1. The highways and transportation commission may issue a request for
9 proposals to sell or lease naming rights for a particular segment of highway or a for a bridge to the
10 best qualified bidder. All contracts for the sale or lease of naming rights shall be first approved by
11 the highways and transportation commission and then approved by the joint committee on
12 transportation. The highways and transportation commission and the joint committee on
13 transportation may disapprove a contract for any reason. The proceeds of a sale or lease of naming
14 rights shall be deposited into the state road fund.

15 2. The purchaser or lessee of a naming right shall pay the cost of erecting, maintaining, and
16 removing signage as well as an annual fee as determined by the proposal.

17 3. The term of contract for naming rights shall not exceed ten years and may be shorter at
18 the discretion of the highways and transportation commission. The purchaser or lessee of a naming
19 right shall have an option of early termination.

20 4. No naming rights shall be sold or leased for any segment of roadway or bridge that has
21 been designated prior to August 28, 2016, as a named memorial highway or bridge under this
22 chapter or through the joint committee on transportation approval process established under section
23 227.297.

24 5. The department of transportation may promulgate all necessary rules and regulations for
25 the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section
26 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it
27 complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section
28 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the
29 general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and
30 annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any
31 rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void.

32 6. The provisions of this section shall expire on December 31, 2036."; and

34 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
35 accordingly.
