FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume this proposal will require the Division of Professional Registration to annually survey political subdivisions and publish a list of political subdivisions that issue electrical contractor licenses whose requirements meet or exceed those of St. Louis County. There is no way to determine the level of effort that will be required to meet the legislation requirements. It may be possible to accomplish these requirements under the existing appropriation; however, if higher than expected survey or publishing costs result from the implementation of this proposal, additional FTE and/or expenses up to \$100,000 may be incurred.

Officials from the **City of Kansas City** and the **City of Columbia** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective cities.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This proposal provides that the license is only valid throughout the state if the political subdivision has statutory authority to issue electrical contractor licenses and requires the Division of Professional Registration within the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration to annually publish a list of authorized political subdivisions.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
