Bill Summary: This proposal specifies that an individual who has been evicted from a rental property must have written permission from the owner of the property to be on the premises in the future.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

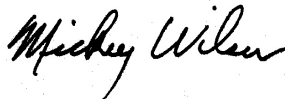
Local Fiscal Highlights
