FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight assumes there will be no direct fiscal impact from this proposal. Oversight notes that due to the penalty provision outlined in the proposal, there will be few, if any violations. Oversight will not reflect the revenue generated from the collection of fines in this fiscal note.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This proposal prohibits commercial dealers, manufacturers, importers, wholesalers, or retailers from selling, leasing, offering for sale, or offering for lease in Missouri any crib bumper pad as an accessory to a crib or as a separate item.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION (continued)


Any violations of the provisions of this proposal will result in a penalty of at least \$100 and no more than \$500 for each offense.

This proposal has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2017.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
