## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

**Oversight** notes this proposal would require a high school student to complete a course on world history in order to graduate. The current high school graduation requirements, set by DESE, require three units of social studies. The three units must allow a student to master areas of civic knowledge and responsibility; economic systems and functions; governmental functions; geography; world history and American history. Currently, one of the three units must be American history and one-half unit must be in government.

**Oversight** assumes that since world history is already allowed but would become required, this proposal would not have an additional fiscal impact. This proposal would just limit the choices the schools could offer for the additional half-credit. The existing social studies teachers would be able to handle the world history course.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume no fiscal impact to the department.

Officials at the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Chillicothe School District** assume no impact as long as this replaces another history class.

Officials at the **Kansas City Public Schools** assume they can not determine the impact until such time as DESE promulgates rules outlining implementation. They assume it would be no impact.

Officials at the **Richmond R-XVI School District** assume they would need to hire another Social Studies teacher at an estimated impact of \$42,000 plus benefits.

Officials at the **Carondelet Leadership Academy, Everton, Malta Bend, New Haven, Pettis County R-XII, Sarcoxie R-II, West Plains** and the **Wright City R-II** school district each assumes there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.
