**Bill Summary:** This proposal allows microbreweries to obtain a license to sell all kinds of intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises of the microbrewery or in close proximity to the microbrewery.

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.


Local Fiscal Highlights

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Alcohol and Tobacco Control** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Certain small businesses that sell intoxicating liquor could be impacted by this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
