AN ACT

To amend chapter 577, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to victim impact programs for driving while intoxicated offenders.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 577, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 577.011, to read as follows:

577.011. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as "Toby's Law".

3 **2. In addition to other terms and conditions imposed on a person who has pled**
4 **guilty to or been found guilty of driving while intoxicated under section 577.010, such**
5 **person shall complete a victim impact program approved by the court. Attendance in such**
6 **program shall be in person unless there are extraordinary circumstances preventing**
7 **in-person attendance. Such person shall be responsible for any charges imposed by the**
8 **victim impact program.**
