AN ACT

To repeal section 142.029, RSMo, relating to the Missouri qualified fuel ethanol producer incentive fund, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 142.029, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

[142.029. Section 142.028 shall expire on December 31, 2015.]

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to encourage economic development
2 in rural areas of the state through the production of renewable fuels, the repeal of section 142.029
3 of section A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health,
4 welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of
5 the constitution, and the repeal of section 142.029 of section A of this act shall be in full force
6 and effect upon its passage and approval.
