AN ACT

To repeal section 105.487, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the filing of personal financial disclosure reports, with an effective date.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 105.487, RSMo, is repealed and one new section
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 105.487, to read as follows:

105.487. The financial interest statements shall be filed at the following
2 times[, but no person is required to file more than one financial interest
3 statement in any calendar year]:

4 (1) Each candidate for elective office, except those candidates for county
5 committee of a political party pursuant to section 115.609 or section 115.611, who
6 is required to file a personal financial disclosure statement shall file a financial
7 interest statement no later than fourteen days after the close of filing at which
8 the candidate seeks nomination or election, and the statement shall be for the
9 twelve months prior to the closing date, except that in the event an individual
10 does not become a candidate until after the date of certification for candidates,
11 the statement shall be filed within fourteen days of the individual's nomination
12 by caucus. An individual required to file a financial interest statement because
13 of the individual's candidacy for office prior to a primary election in accordance
14 with this section is also required to amend such statement no later than the close
15 of business on Monday prior to the general election to reflect any changes in
16 financial interest during the interim. The appropriate election authority shall
17 provide to the candidate at the time of filing for election written notice of the
18 candidate's obligation to file pursuant to sections 105.483 to 105.492 and the

19 candidate shall sign a statement acknowledging receipt of such notice;

20 (2) Each person appointed to office, except any person elected for county
21 committee of a political party pursuant to section 115.617, and each official or
22 employee described in section 105.483 who is not otherwise covered in this
23 subsection shall file the statement within thirty days of such appointment or
24 employment;

25 (3) Every other person required by sections 105.483 to 105.492 to file a
26 financial interest statement shall file the statement [~~annually~~] **biannually** not
27 later than the [~~first~~] **fifteenth** day of [~~May and~~] **January** for the statement
28 **that** shall cover the [~~calendar year ending the immediately preceding~~] **period**
29 **from July first to** December thirty-first **of the preceding year, and not**
30 **later than July fifteenth for the statement that shall cover the period**
31 **from January first to June thirtieth of the same calendar year;** provided
32 that the governor, lieutenant governor, any member of the general assembly or
33 any member of the governing body of a political subdivision may supplement such
34 person's financial interest statement to report additional interests acquired after
35 [~~December thirty-first of the covered year until the date of~~] **any deadline for**
36 filing of [~~the~~] **a** financial interest statement;

37 (4) The deadline for filing any statement required by sections 105.483 to
38 105.492 shall be 5:00 p.m. of the last day designated for filing the
39 statement. When the last day of filing falls on a Saturday or Sunday or on an
40 official state holiday, the deadline for filing is extended to 5:00 p.m. on the next
41 day which is not a Saturday or Sunday or official holiday. Any statement
42 required within a specified time shall be deemed to be timely filed if it is
43 postmarked not later than midnight of the day previous to the last day designated
44 for filing the statement.

Section B. The repeal and reenactment of section 105.487 of this act shall
2 become effective on July 1, 2017.

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
