## AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to department of conservation resident permits.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 252.285, to read as follows:

2 **252.285. Any United States citizen who is not a resident of Missouri but is employed**  
3 **at least forty hours per week in Missouri and pays income taxes in Missouri who applies**  
4 **for a hunting, fishing, or trapping license or permit with the department of conservation**  
5 **shall be issued a resident hunting, fishing, or trapping license or permit if all other**  
6 **department regulations are met. Such nonresident shall pay the same fee as a resident**  
applicant for such license or permit.
