AN ACT

To repeal section 67.1571, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the minimum wage.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 67.1571, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 67.1571, to read as follows:

67.1571. 1. No municipality shall establish, mandate, or otherwise require a minimum wage that exceeds the state minimum wage.

2. For purposes of this section, "municipality" means any city, town, or village, including any city not within a county.

[67.1571. No municipality as defined in section 1, paragraph 2, subsection (9) shall establish, mandate or otherwise require a minimum wage that exceeds the state minimum wage.]
