AN ACT

To amend chapter 290, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to access to job opportunities for minority members of labor organizations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 290, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 290.700, to read as follows:

290.700. 1. There is hereby established a committee of the house of representatives to be known as the "Labor Organization Minority Discrimination Interim Committee".

2. The membership of the committee shall consist of:

(1) Members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives;

(2) One member employed by the office of administration, appointed by the governor; and

(3) One member employed by the department of labor and industrial relations, appointed by the governor.

3. The speaker of the house of representatives shall choose the number of members of the house of representatives who shall serve on the committee.

4. The committee shall meet at least one time during the interim between the session ending on the thirtieth day of May and the session commencing on the first Wednesday after the first Monday of January.

5. The committee shall study:

(1) The practices of Missouri's labor organizations regarding access to ample job opportunities for minority members of labor organizations; and
