

HB 1547 -- ENERGY BENCHMARK TRANSPARENCY ACT

SPONSOR: McNeil

This bill creates the Energy Benchmark Transparency Act. Beginning September 1, 2016, the owner of every public building in the state must use the Energy Star Portfolio Manager to measure and track, including establishing benchmarks, the energy and water consumption of each permanent public building for which an Energy Star rating system exists. The data must be reported to the Department of Economic Development's Division of Energy annually.
