

HB 1601 -- STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

SPONSOR: Ruth

This bill requires the Governor to appoint a teacher representative to the State Board of Education (SBE). This teacher representative must attend all SBE meetings and participate in deliberations. However, the teacher representative will not have the right to vote on any matter or be counted in establishing a quorum.

The teacher must be a resident of Missouri, certified to teach, and employed full-time as a teacher in the state and not on leave.

The teacher's term will be four years and subsequent appointments will be made in rotation from each congressional district, beginning with the First Congressional District and continuing in numerical order.
