

HB 1825 -- FIREARM DISCHARGE ACROSS PROPERTY LINE

SPONSOR: McGaugh

This bill creates the crime of firearm discharge across a property line. An individual is guilty of this crime if he or she knowingly discharges a firearm while hunting or target shooting and its projectile travels across a property boundary line. It is a defense to this crime if an individual owns all of the property involved, or has written permission from all property owners allowing the shooting practices. A violation of this offense is a class C misdemeanor.
