HB 1827 -- DAMAGES FROM LIVESTOCK TRESPASS (McGaugh)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Civil and Criminal Proceedings.

This bill specifies that the owner of any horse, cattle, or other stock that breaks over or through a lawful fence and obtains access to or trespasses upon another's property is liable for damages sustained if the owner of the trespassing animal was negligent.

This bill is the same as HB 372 (2015).
