

HB 1896 -- GENERAL ASSEMBLY BENEFITS

SPONSOR: Otto

This bill provides that any individual who first serves as a member of the General Assembly on or after January 1, 2017, will not receive coverage provided by the state and must be responsible for 100% of the premium cost for health, life, and disability insurance coverage while active or retired.

Beginning January 1, 2017, any individual who first serves as a member of the General Assembly will not receive state funded retirement benefits.

This bill is the same as HB 1258 (2015).
