

HB 2253 -- LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER CITATIONS

SPONSOR: Curtman

This bill prohibits a law enforcement officer from being required to issue a specific number of citations within a designated period of time. This provision cannot affect the conditions of any federal or state grants or funds awarded and used to fund traffic enforcement programs. The number of citations issued by a law enforcement officer cannot be compared to citations issued by another law enforcement officer who has similar job duties for the purpose of evaluating an officer's job performance.

This bill is the same as HB 429 (2015).
