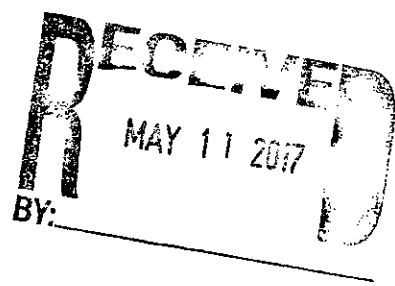

SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill Nos. 302 & 228, Page 16, Section 190.165, Line 25,

2 of said page, by inserting immediately after said line the
3 following:

4 "210.1014. 1. There is hereby created the "Amber Alert
5 System Oversight Committee", whose primary duty shall be to
6 develop criteria and procedures for the Amber alert system and
7 shall be housed within the department of public safety. The
8 committee shall regularly review the function of the Amber alert
9 system and revise its criteria and procedures in cooperation with
10 the department of public safety to provide for efficient and
11 effective public notification and meet at least annually to
12 discuss potential improvements to the Amber alert system. As
13 soon as practicable, the committee shall adopt criteria and
14 procedures to expand the Amber alert system to provide urgent
15 public alerts related to homeland security, criminal acts, health
16 emergencies, and other imminent dangers to the public health and
17 welfare.

18 2. The Amber alert system oversight committee shall consist
19 of ten members of which seven members shall be appointed by the
20 governor with the advice and consent of the senate. Such members
21 shall represent the following entities: two representatives of
22 the Missouri Sheriffs' Association; two representatives of the
23 Missouri Police Chiefs Association; one representative of small

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1 market radio broadcasters; one representative of large market
2 radio broadcasters; one representative of television
3 broadcasters. The director of the department of public safety
4 shall also be a member of the committee and shall serve as chair
5 of the committee. Additional members shall include one
6 representative of the highway patrol and one representative of
7 the department of health and senior services.

8 3. Members of the oversight committee shall serve a term of
9 four years, except that members first appointed to the committee
10 shall have staggered terms of two, three, and four years and
11 shall serve until their successor is duly appointed and
12 qualified.

13 4. Members of the oversight committee shall serve without
14 compensation, except that members shall be reimbursed for their
15 actual and necessary expenses required for the discharge of their
16 duties.

17 5. The Amber alert system oversight committee shall
18 promulgate rules for the implementation of the Amber alert
19 system. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined
20 in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated
21 in this section shall become effective only if it complies with
22 and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if
23 applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are
24 nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general
25 assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the
26 effective date or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently
27 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and
28 any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2003, shall be
29 invalid and void.

1 210.1016. 1. The provisions of this section shall be known
2 and may be cited as "Hailey's Law".

3 2. The Amber alert system shall be integrated into the
4 Missouri uniform law enforcement system (MULES) and Regional
5 Justice Information Service (REJIS) to expedite the reporting of
6 child abductions."; and
