1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 411, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by
2 inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "173.1004. 1. The coordinating board shall promulgate rules and regulations to ensure that
5 each approved public higher education institution shall post on its website the names of all faculty,
6 including adjunct, part-time, and full-time faculty, who are given full or partial teaching
7 assignments along with web links or other means of providing information about their academic
8 credentials and, where feasible, instructor ratings by students. In addition, public institutions of
9 higher education shall post course schedules on their websites that include the name of the instructor
10 assigned to each course and, if applicable, each section of a course, as well as identifying those
11 instructors who are teaching assistants, provided that the institution may modify and update the
12 identity of instructors as courses and sections are added or cancelled.

13 2. All public institutions of higher education shall post on their public websites alongside
14 their degree offerings or publish in their course catalogs alongside their degree offerings all of the
15 following information for each degree program offered:

16 (1) Estimated cost of the degree based on the hours required to complete the degree
17 program, the books likely required to complete the degree program, and the on-campus housing
18 costs for the number of academic years likely required to complete the degree program;

19 (2) Types of employment opportunities generally expected to be available for students who
20 earn the degree;

21 (3) The current job market for people who have earned the degree. Such description of the
22 current job market shall include estimates of the numbers of jobs available in the industries in which
23 people who have earned the degree typically work;

24 (4) The number and percentage of students who earned the degree employed within one
25 year of graduation for the most recent graduating class for which data are available and, for the
26 students so employed, their average income; and

27 (5) The number and percentage of students who earned the degree employed within one
28 year of graduation in a field closely related to the degree program for the most recent graduating
29 class for which data are available."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
32 accordingly.
