

HB 221 -- UNITED STATES SENATOR DUTIES

SPONSOR: Moon

This bill requests that United States Senators from this state appear from time to time before the General Assembly to answer questions involving federal law and state affairs and take action on recommendations from the General Assembly. The General Assembly acting as a committee of the whole may use its power of legislative subpoena to obtain information on the activities of the federal government if a Senator fails to appear for an unreasonable period of time.

This bill is the same as HB 2800 (2016).
