

HB 567 -- CONVEYANCE OF STATE PROPERTY

SPONSOR: Green

Generally, the Governor may not convey or otherwise transfer the fee title to any real property owned by Missouri unless such a conveyance is approved by the General Assembly, or the Board of Public Buildings when a state agency so requests. This bill exempts state conveyances from the required General Assembly approval when involving easements to any political subdivision, to accommodate utility service, and to facilitate the construction, location, and relocation of a condominium property when the state is a unit owner in the condominium. The easements shall include the right to maintain or remove any street, roadway, sidewalk, public right-of-way, thoroughfare, gas line, water or stream line, or telephone line Internet cable.
