

HB 931 -- ETHICS

SPONSOR: Arthur

This bill requires persons and entities, including all types of nonprofit organizations, that engage in specified electioneering activities to file disclosure reports with the Missouri Ethics Commissions. Persons or entities spending more than \$1000 on electioneering activities involving certain communications to the public must file a report within 48 hours. Entities that engage primarily in electioneering and that do not segregate their funds are subject to specified donor disclosure requirements involving all donations made in the year prior to electioneering activity subject to reporting under the bill, whereas entities that establish a segregated bank account used for all of their electioneering activities are subject to the disclosure of specified donor information involving the segregated bank account for the year prior to the electioneering activity subject to reporting under the bill. Reports required by the bill shall be filed electronically with the commission.
