

HB 956 -- CONVEYANCE OF STATE PROPERTY

SPONSOR: Kidd

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Corrections and Public Institutions by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Committee on Consent and House Procedure by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill authorizes the Director of the Department of Natural Resources to convey certain state property, specified in the bill, located in Jackson County, Missouri, to the City of Independence.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is a really good idea because the City of Independence already leases this property and would be willing to invest in the major repairs this land requires if the land would be conveyed to them.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Kidd and Laren Palmer.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.

OTHERS: Others testifying on the bill say this conveyance would be a win for all parties involved.
