

HB 1032 -- REAL ID Compliant Drivers' Licenses

SPONSOR: Green

This bill provides that documents required to be retained under the REAL ID Act are exempt from the prohibition against retaining any documents used to obtain a driver's license.

The bill also authorizes the Department of Revenue to collect an additional fee for issuing a REAL ID compliant driver's license or identification card, but prohibits the fee from exceeding the cost of implementing a REAL ID compliant system.

The bill requires the department to amend its procedures for applying for a driver's license or identification card in order to comply with the federal REAL ID Act. The department is currently prevented from complying with the act.

A provision requiring that biometric data be deleted is limited to such data collected before August 28, 2017.

No provision regarding the collection of biometric data can prevent the department from complying with any requirement of the REAL ID Act.
