1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2005, Page 1, Enacting Clause, Line 3,

3 by deleting "enumerated in each section" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 "described herein";

7 further amend said bill, said page, Enacting Clause, Line 5, by inserting immediately after said line  
8 the following:

10 **"PART 1**

11 Section 5.000. Each appropriation in this act shall consist of the item or items in each section of  
12 Part 1 of this act, for the amount and purpose and from the fund designated in each section of Part  
13 1, as well as all additional clarifications of purpose in Part 2 of this act that make reference by  
14 section to said item or items in Part 1. Any clarification of purpose in Part 2 shall state the section  
15 or sections in Part 1 to which it attaches and shall, together with the language of said section(s) in  
16 Part 1, form the complete statement of purpose of the appropriation. As such, the provisions of  
17 Part 2 of this act shall not be severed from Part 1, and if any clarification of purpose in Part 2 is for  
18 any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall invalidate all of the appropriations in this act of  
19 which said clarification of purpose is a part.";

20  
21 further amend said bill, Page 27, Section 5.530, Line 7, by inserting immediately after said section  
22 the following:

24 **"PART 2**

25 Section 5.600. To the Office of Administration

26 In reference to Section 5.005 through and including Section 5.295 of Part 1 of this act:

27 No State expenditures authorized hereunder shall be for contracts or purchases from any business  
28 entity that has not provided a certification to the State that such business entity does not discriminate  
29 against or refuse to do business with any individuals based on such individuals' sexual orientation or  
30 gender identity."
