1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2265, Page 6, Section 386.390, Line 32,
2 by inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "386.1200. The commission shall have authority to approve programs or rates for electrical
5 corporations that are designed to assist low-income residential customers in restoring or retaining
6 access to essential electric utility services while also seeking to mitigate the adverse financial
7 impacts experienced by other customers as a result of the loss in revenue contribution and the
8 increase in disconnection, reconnection, collection, call center, and other expenses that occur when
9 such customers cannot maintain utility service. The aggregate impact of any special low-income
10 rate shall be limited to no more than one-half of one percent of the total revenue requirement
11 allocated to the residential customer class used to set rates. The commission shall not require any
12 electrical corporation to verify the financial status of its customers, and shall permit electrical
13 corporations to rely upon a third party or community agency to verify any eligibility requirements
14 approved by the commission in order for a residential customer to qualify for a low-income
15 program or rate approved under this section."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
18 accordingly.
