1 AMEND House Committee Bill No. 11, Page 1, Section A, Line 4, by inserting immediately after  
2 said section and line the following:

4 "193.245. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit inspection of, or to disclose  
5 information contained in, vital records or to copy or issue a copy of all or part of any such record  
6 except as authorized by this law and by regulation or by order of a court of competent jurisdiction  
7 or in the following situations:

8 (1) A listing of persons who are born ~~[or who die]~~ on a particular date may be disclosed  
9 upon request, but no information from the record other than the name and the date of such birth ~~[or~~  
10 ~~death]~~ shall be disclosed;

11 (2) A listing of persons who die on a particular date shall be disclosed upon request, but no  
12 information from the record other than the name and the date of such death shall be disclosed;

13 (3) The department may authorize the disclosure of information contained in vital records  
14 for legitimate research purposes;

15 ~~[(3)]~~ (4) To a qualified applicant as provided in section 193.255;

16 ~~[(4)]~~ (5) Copies of death records over fifty years old may be disclosed upon request."; and

18 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
19 accordingly.
