## AN ACT

To repeal section 544.150, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to rewards by county commissions.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 544.150, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 544.150, to read as follows:

544.150. Whenever the county commission of any county in this state, or any two commissioners thereof in vacation, shall be satisfied that any felony has been committed in said county, such commission or commissioners may, at their discretion, offer a standing reward of not exceeding ~~[five hundred]~~ **one hundred thousand** dollars for the apprehension and arrest of the person or persons committing the same, which reward shall be paid out of the county treasury; but in no instance shall any reward, or any part thereof, be paid to any person who may be entitled thereto until final conviction of the defendant.
