## AN ACT

To amend chapter 32, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the department of revenue.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 32, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 32.310, to read as follows:

3 **32.310. 1. The department of revenue shall create and maintain a mapping feature**  
4 **on its official public website that displays tax information of political subdivisions of this**  
5 **state that have taxing authority, including the current tax rate for each tax imposed and**  
6 **collected, the year in which the tax was first imposed, and the statutory or constitutional**  
7 **authority for imposing each tax. Such display shall have the option to showcase the**  
8 **borders and jurisdiction of the following political subdivisions on a map of the state:**  
9       **(1) Ambulance districts;**  
10       **(2) Community improvement districts;**  
11       **(3) Fire protection districts;**  
12       **(4) Levee districts;**  
13       **(5) Library districts;**  
14       **(6) Neighborhood improvement districts;**  
15       **(7) Port authority districts;**  
          **(8) Tax increment financing districts;**  
          **(9) Transportation development districts;**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

16           **(10) School districts; or**

17           **(11) Any other political subdivision that imposes a tax within its borders and**  
18 **jurisdiction.**

19           **2. The mapping feature shall also have the option to superimpose state house of**  
20 **representative districts and state senate districts over the political subdivisions.**

21           **3. The department of revenue may contract with another entity to build and**  
22 **maintain the mapping feature.**

23           **4. The department shall implement the mapping feature by July 1, 2019.**
