### AN ACT

To repeal section 49.070, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to county commissions.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 49.070, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 49.070, to read as follows:

49.070. A majority of the commissioners of the county commission shall constitute a quorum to do business; a single member may adjourn from day to day, and require the attendance of those absent; when but two commissioners are sitting and they shall disagree in any matter submitted to them, the decision of the presiding commissioner shall stand as the decision of the commission; provided further, when the presiding commissioner is absent and the other two commissioners are present the commission clerk shall designate one of the commissioners present as presiding commissioner during the absence of the regular presiding commissioner, and he **or she** shall, during the absence of the regular presiding commissioner, have all of the powers of the regular presiding commissioner. **The presiding commissioner shall preside over all county commission meetings.**
