

HB 2186 -- PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX

SPONSOR: Toalson Reisch

This bill adds certain cities to the list of cities authorized to impose, upon voter approval, a sales tax of up to .05% for public safety purposes, including expenditures on equipment, city employee salaries and benefits, and facilities for police, fire and emergency medical providers.

Currently, the only additional city described is Centralia.

This bill is the same as SB 885 (2018).
